

MINUTES OF WORKSESSION
OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF MELISSA
MARCH 9, 2004
6:30 P.M.

Mayor David Dorman called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Council Members present were: Bill Reynolds, Randy Kaiser, Stan Mercer. Teri Newsome arrived at 6:38 p.m. and Kelly Maberry arrived at 6:40 p.m.

The City of Melissa City Council reviewed the City's Landscape Ordinance and made suggested changes to the document.

Councilman Kaiser initiated discussion regarding the final notation of the Landscape Ordinance referring to reimbursing residents for replacement of screening trees/shrubs removed during city upgrades. After extensive discussion, it was felt that since the trees or shrubs referred to would be in the City's right of way, the City would not be responsible for replacing or reimbursing the property owner for them. It was decided that the paragraph should not be part of the final document.

Mayor Dorman requested that the Red Tip Photinia be deleted from the list of suggested shrubs that can be used to create a 42 inch high screening wall. This particular shrub is disease oriented and is not a viable choice.

Changes will be made and presented in a revised format at the next Council meeting.

Motion was made by Bill Reynolds and seconded by Teri Newsome to adjourn the work session.
