

## LEGAL NOTICE ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

The City of Melissa, Texas is accepting sealed bids for construction of:  
**Traffic Signal – SH 5 (McKinney Street) at Pennsylvania Ave.**

The project is generally described as: **Installation of Traffic Signal at SH 5 (McKinney St.) and Pennsylvania Ave.,** for the City of Melissa, Texas as shown in plans prepared by TxDOT.

Following bid opening, tabulation will be made for consideration of the City of Melissa in awarding a contract.
