## **Melissa Police Department Respond to Apparent Suicide**

Melissa, Texas - At approximately 12:00 p.m. on Saturday, March 3, 2018, the Melissa Police Department responded to a call of a possibly deceased person near the Northbound service road in the 2900 block of Central Expressway in Melissa.

Upon arrival, officers located the deceased person. The Melissa Police Department, Collin County Sheriff's Office and the Melissa Fire Department conducted a joint investigation into the circumstances surrounding the death.

The white male, positively identified, had died from self-inflicted wounds. The body was transported to the Medical Examiner Office in McKinney. The immediate family has been notified. The public is not in danger from this incident.
