**ITEM #5**

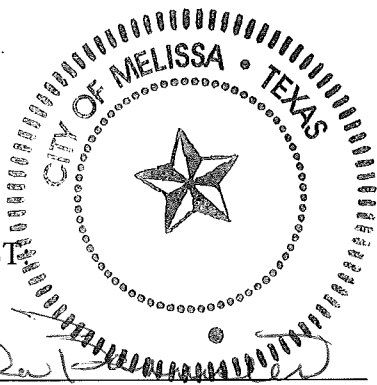
Council reviewed and discussed a proposed Code of Ethics for the City.
