
Members Absent: Courtney Willis (held her orientation prior to the meeting)

City Manager Jason Little and City Attorney Ryan Pittman conducted an overview of the Commission's responsibilities and purpose. City Staff then provided an overview of potential propositions to the community to address various textual changes that relate to the following topics:

- Add provision to all for non-substantive revisions;
- Clarify Mayor Pro Tem selection process;
- Clarify Mayoral powers;
- Clarify Runoff elections are decided by plurality;
- Replace registered voters with qualified voters;
- Modify vacancy to be allowed by appointment;
- Modify allowed methods of required Publications; and
- Remove obsolete transitional provisions.

No decisions were made at this meeting. The second meeting will be held on Wednesday, May 3, and will cover the reminder of the staff-identified possible revisions. Staff is also asking for any other topics the commission would like to cover so Staff can prepare the necessary research for the Commission to review.
